Growing peppers using the Spanish Method is expensive when using wooden, bulky, and heavy poles. The distance between the twines narrows near each pole which stress the plants, at the end of the season disassembly, cleanup and sterilization must be done, which are time-consuming and physically hard to do.

With Paskal's pepper support, the grower is able to use twines instead of poles. The twines are spread out on both sides of the plants along the row, supporting them from falling to either side. As the plants grow higher, more and more horizontal lines of twine are added.

- Attach the two horizontal twines as well as the vertical twine to the pepper support
- For the first and second levels use item 5700, above that use 5707
- $\cdot~$ This method can hold up to 5 horizontal lines
